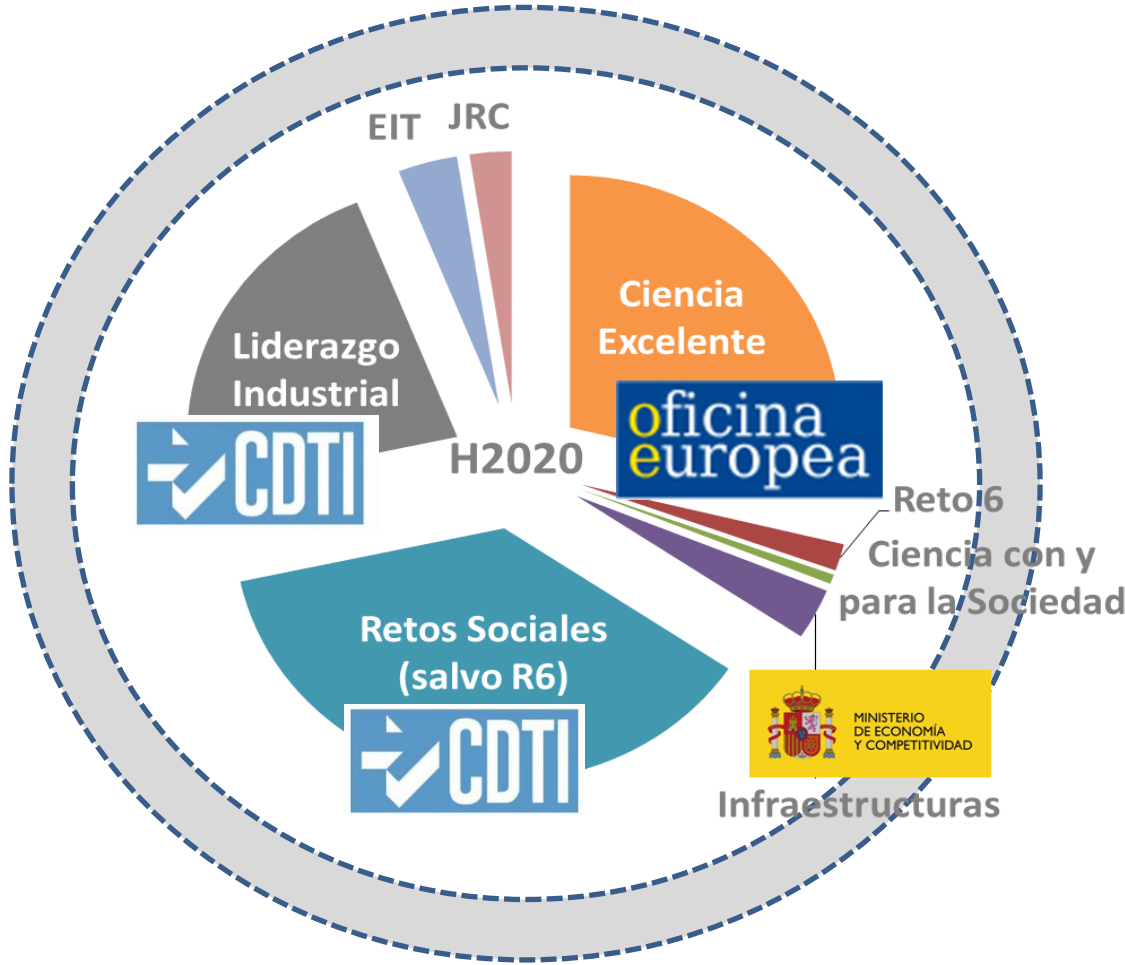

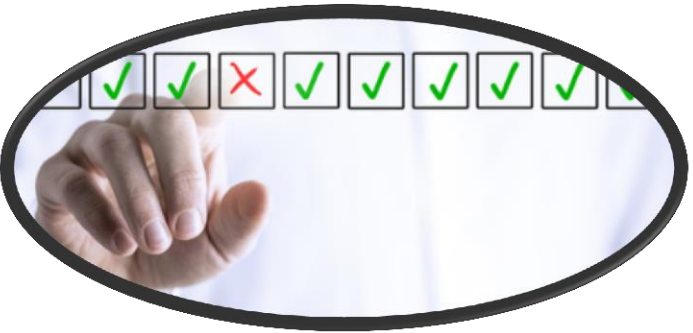

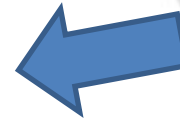

Brief description of the Institution:

The Institute of Chemical Research of Catalonia -ICIQ- (www.icq.es) started its research activities in 2004. ICIQ is a research centre of excellence accredited with the Severo Ochoa award and it is a member of the recently founded Barcelona Institute of Science and Technology (www.bist.eu).

ICIQ is one of the top level institutions for chemical research and has become an internationally recognised leading institution in the field of chemistry, as demonstrated by its participation in 46 projects from FP7 and H2020 programmes, including 15 ERC projects and 4 ITN networks. ICIQ is also very successful in obtaining MSCA-IF with 9 MSCA fellows from the H2020 framework programme.

The Institute is committed to performing research at the frontiers of knowledge in the areas of Catalysis and Renewable energies and steering the technological transfer of knowledge to the chemical and energy sectors by training the next generation of scientists through our high-quality educational programmes.

Brief description of the Centre/Research Group (including URL if applicable):

The [research group of Prof. A. Llobet](#) carries out research in the field of redox catalysis using transition metal complexes. They are interested in the oxidation and reduction of both organic and inorganic substrates, and mainly those that are of technological interest. Their overall objective is to understand the various factors that affect catalyst's efficiency and selectivity with special focus to the transition metal electronic structure and space disposition.

Particular attention is being paid to the catalytic oxidation of water to molecular dioxygen, given the implications of this reaction for new energy conversion schemes based on artificial photosynthesis. The final objective of this route consists in the photo-production of hydrogen from water and sunlight.

Project description:

A competitive project that merges Prof. Llobet group's expertise and the candidate's research experience aiming at high impact results to advance the knowledge of the molecular science related to photoinduced catalytic water oxidation and proton reductions.

- A full CV (including publications)
- A brief summary of the research project they would like to develop at ICIQ

III. MSCA - IF 2018: Eligible researchers

Candidates must , by the call deadline 12/09/2018

Be experienced researchers (ER):

- have a doctoral degree
- at least 4 years of full-time equivalent research experience.



Comply with the mobility rule:

- Candidates must not have **lived and/or worked** in the country of the host institution for a certain period of time.
- For GF this rule applies at the contry of the partner organisation.

Nationality restrictions apply in some cases:

- **RI:** nationals or long term residents in MS or AC.
- **GF:** nationals or long term residents in MS or AC



III. MSCA - IF 2018: Eligible institutions

HOST INSTITUTION



BENEFICIARY

- **Recruits, Hosts, and trains the fellow,**
- Must be located in a Member State (MS) or Associated Country (AC)
- Receives funding from EC.
- Signs the Grant Agreement with the EC.

Academic host

- Public or private Higher Education Institutions awarding academic degrees
- Public or private non-private research organizations
- International European Interest Organisations

Non-academic host

Any other socio-economic actor not included in the academic sector definition (SME, enterprises, NGOs, hospitals, government bodies, museums, libraries...)

PARTNER ORGANISATION

- Does not recruit the fellow, offers **additional training** and hosts the researcher during his / her:

III. MSCA IF – EF – Standard (ST)

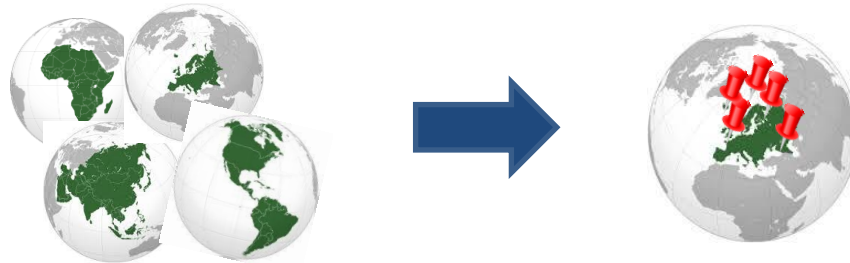


For fellows coming or moving within Europe

- **No restriction** to nationality applies.
- **Mobility Rule:** At the deadline (12/09/18) the researcher must have not resided /carried out main activity in the country of the Host Institution (MS/AC) for more than 12 months in the last 36 months
- **Duration** of the project between 12 and 24 months
- **8 scientific panels**



III. MSCA IF – EF – Career Restart Panel (CAR)



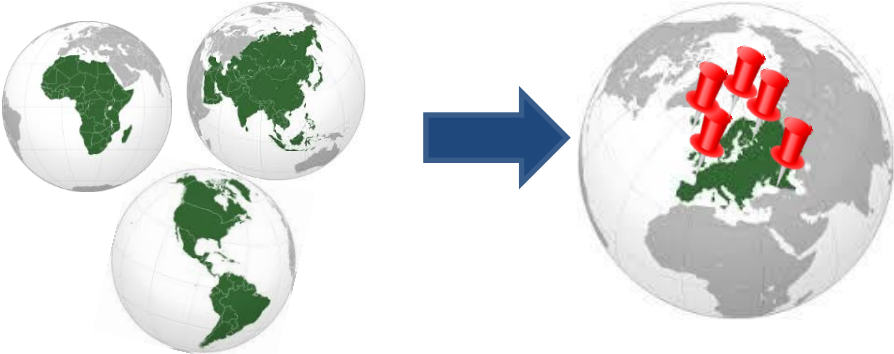
For researchers who want to resume research in Europe after a career break.

- **Career break** : *the researcher must not have been active for a continuous period of **12 months within the last 18 months.***
- No restriction to nationality applies
- **Relaxed Mobility Rule**: no more than 3 years in the 5 years
- **Duration** of the project between 12 and **36 months.** **NEW**
- Multidisciplinary panel.

III. MSCA IF – EF – Reintegration Panel (RI)



For **European*** researchers who want to return from a TC and reintegrate in Europe.

- **Direct mobility** from a Third Country to the Member State / Associated Country.
- **Relaxed Mobility Rule:** no more than 3 years in the 5 years.
- **Restriction to nationality:** **National or long-term residents of a MS or AC.*
- Multidisciplinary panel.
- Duration of the project between 12 and 24 months.

III. MSCA IF – EF – Society and Enterprise (SE)



For fellows coming or moving within Europe who want to develop their research career outside academia.

- Host institution from the **non-academic sector**: *non-academics organisations, from industry to business (including SMEs), government, civil society organisations (NGOs, trusts, foundations, etc.), some cultural institutions, museums, hospitals, and international organisations (like the UN or WHO)*
- **Relaxed Mobility Rule**: no more than 3 years in the 5 years.
- **No restriction** to nationality applies.
- Multidisciplinary panel.
- Duration of the project between 12 and 24 months.



III. MSCA – IF – EF – Widening Fellowships (WF)

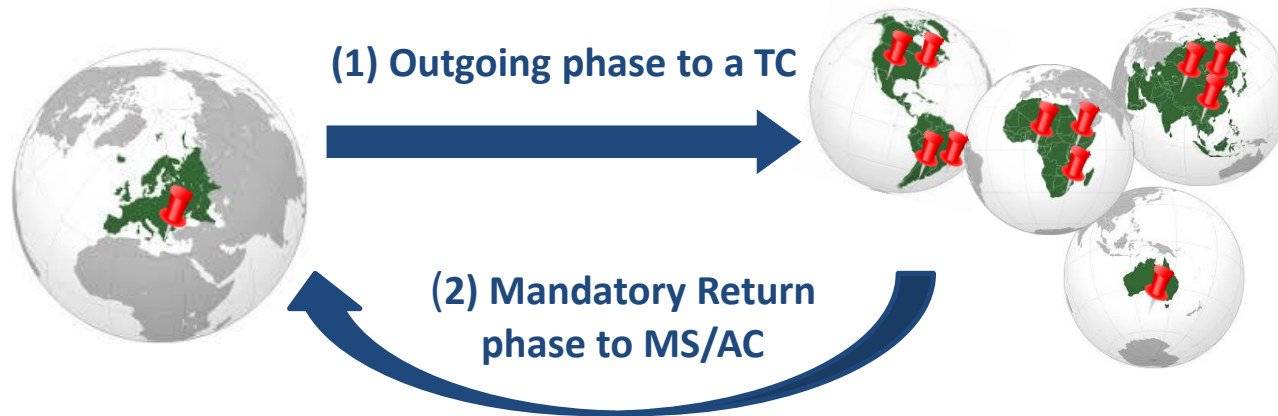
NEW

- Support researchers, regardless of their nationality, to **undertake their fellowship in a Widening country.**
- Aim: **help spread excellence and close the research and innovation gap within Europe**
- Normal award criteria, scoring and thresholds for MSCA – IF will apply
- EF proposals from all scientific areas which cannot be funded under EF and have a chance to be funded under WF will therefore be **ranked in one single list** according to the scores and evaluation procedure of the MSCA IF Call
- At submission stage applicants are asked in section 5 (Part A – Call Specific Questions) whether or not they wish to be considered for this funding opportunity

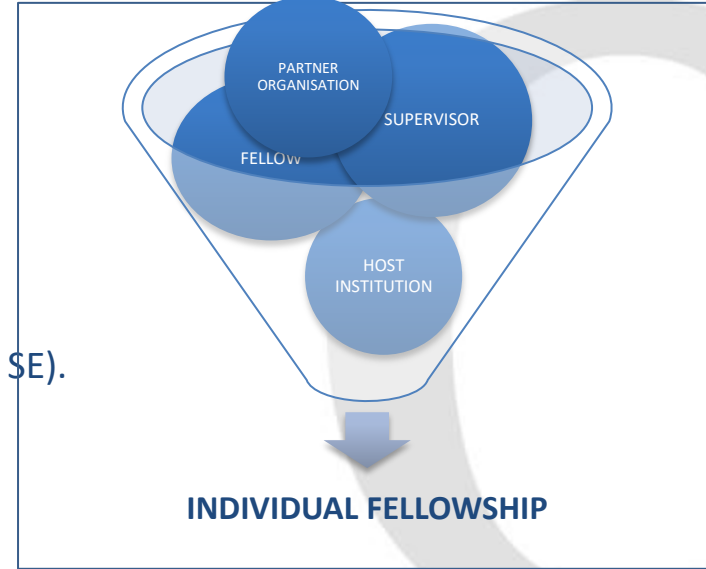
III. MSCA – IF – GF: Global Fellowships (GF)



- Duration: 12-24 months, outgoing phase in a TC + 12 months returning phase in Europe.
- ER eligible: nationals and long-term residents in MS / AC (more flexible resident rule)** **NEW**
- Mobility from any country to the TC of the outgoing phase
- Mobility rule to be fulfilled in the TC of the outgoing phase
- Minimum participation: 1 beneficiary in MS / AC (host institution) + 1 Partner Organisation in TC
- Letter of Commitment** from Partner Organisation in TC compulsory
- Initial phase in Europe: up to 3 months if needed** **NEW**

III. How does it work?

- **Joint preparation:** ER and the Host Institution (Beneficiary)
- A researcher (ER) can only submit **one proposal**
- **Bottom-up:** 8 scientific panels + 3 Multidisciplinary Panels (CAR + RI + SE).

III. MSCA – IF 2018: some characteristics

- **Individual research project:** training-through-research under the direct supervision of the supervisor / key staff of the institution.
- **Hands on training:**
 - ✓ for developing scientific skills (new techniques, instruments, etc.)
 - ✓ For developing and acquiring transferable skills:
 - ❖ Proposal preparation to request funding
 - ❖ Patent applications, management of IPR, take up and exploitation of results, entrepreneurship...
 - ❖ Action management, task coordination, how to properly communicate
 - ❖ Gender issues, research integrity, Open Science, etc.
- Intersectoral or interdisciplinary transfer of knowledge (**secondments...**)
- Organization of scientific / Training / dissemination events
- **Communication, outreach activities, public engagement**

III. MSCA – IF 2018: secondments

- ✓ **Have to take place in a Partner Organisation in a MS / AC**
- ✓ **Meaningful and appropriate** to the type of fellowship and research field
- ✓ Importance of the involvement of the non-academic sector
- ✓ Partner Organisations: no need to include a letter of commitment
- ✓ Clearly justified in Part B (just 1 P.O in Part A)

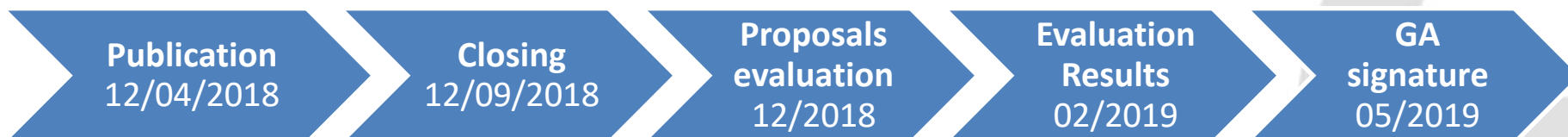

Of the **maximum 10 pages** applied to sections 1, 2 and 3, applicants are free to decide on the allocation of pages between the sections. However, the overall page limit will be strictly applied: after the call deadline, **excess pages will automatically be made invisible, and will not be taken into consideration by the experts.**

It is the responsibility of the applicant to verify that the submitted PDF documents are readable and are within the page limit. PDF documents can contain colours.

Part B-2:

Part B-2 must contain sections 4-7 as described below. **No overall page limit** will be applied to this document, but applicants should respect the instructions given per section (e.g. in section 5, a maximum of one page should be used per beneficiary and one page per partner organisation).

- Section 4: CV of the experienced researcher (maximum length: 5 pages)
- Section 5: Capacities of the participating organisations (1 page for the overview and 1 page for each participating organisation)
- Section 6: Ethical aspects
- Section 7: Letter of commitment of the partner organisation (for GF only)

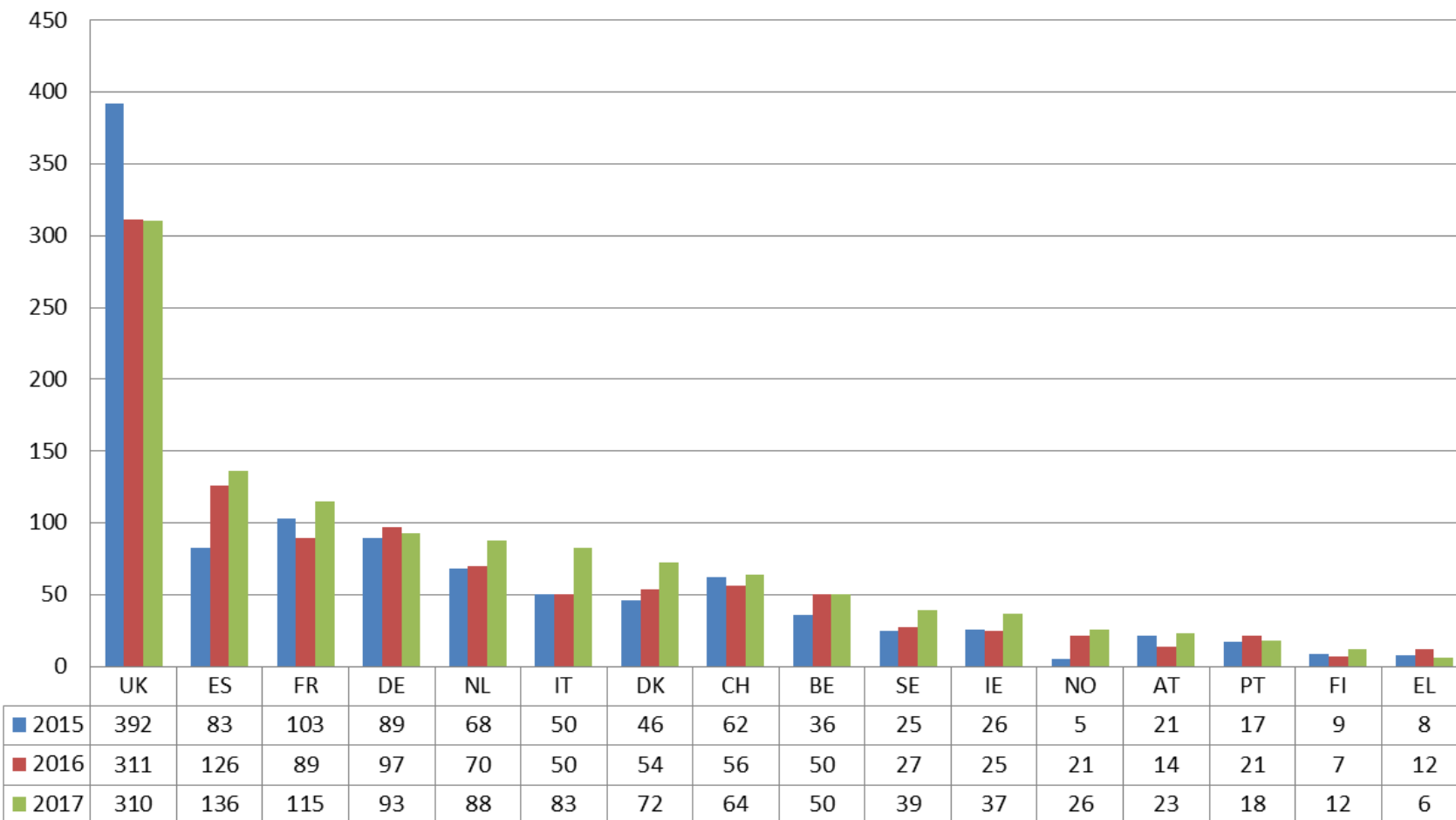

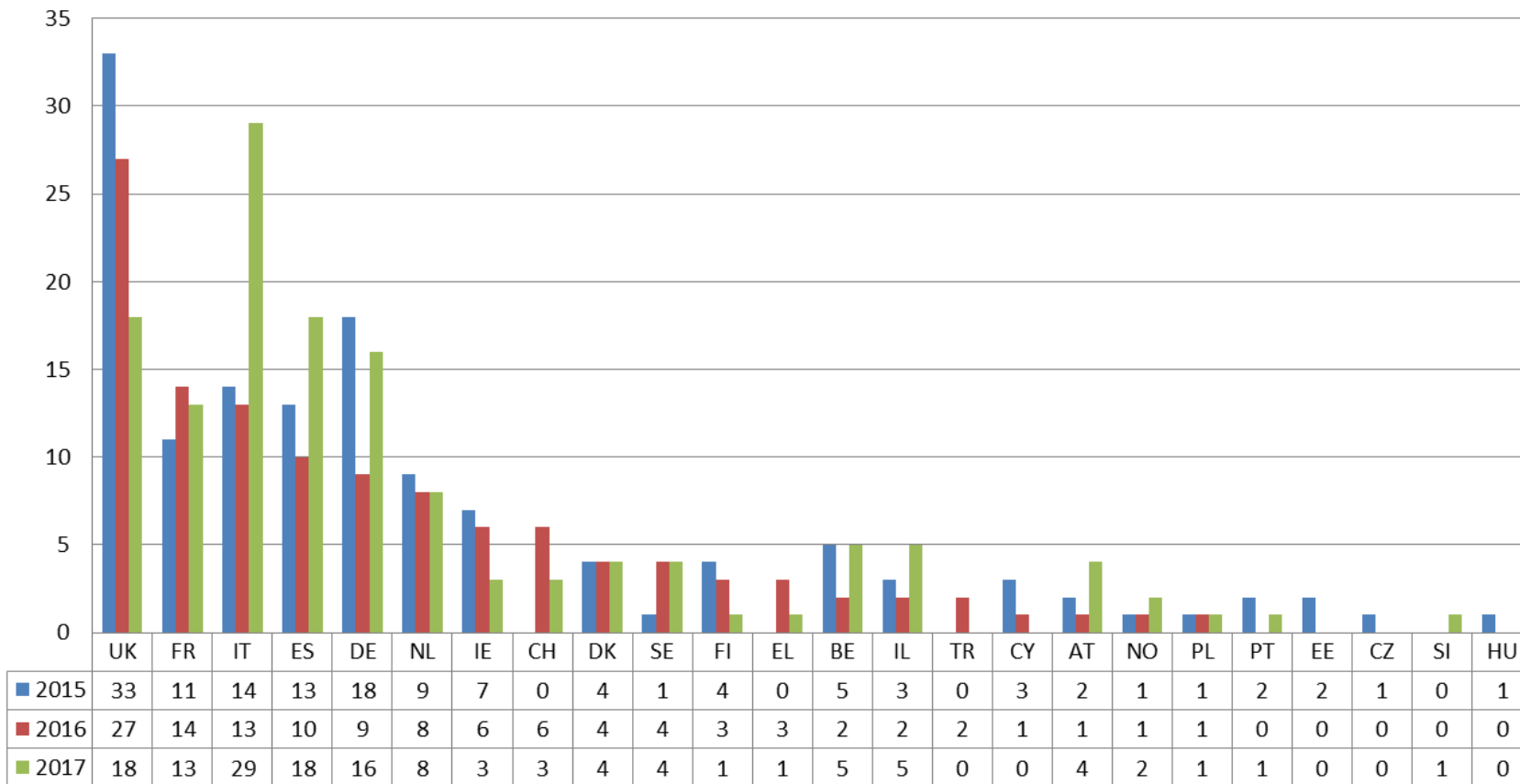

IF-EF 2017: Funded proposals per country (1)

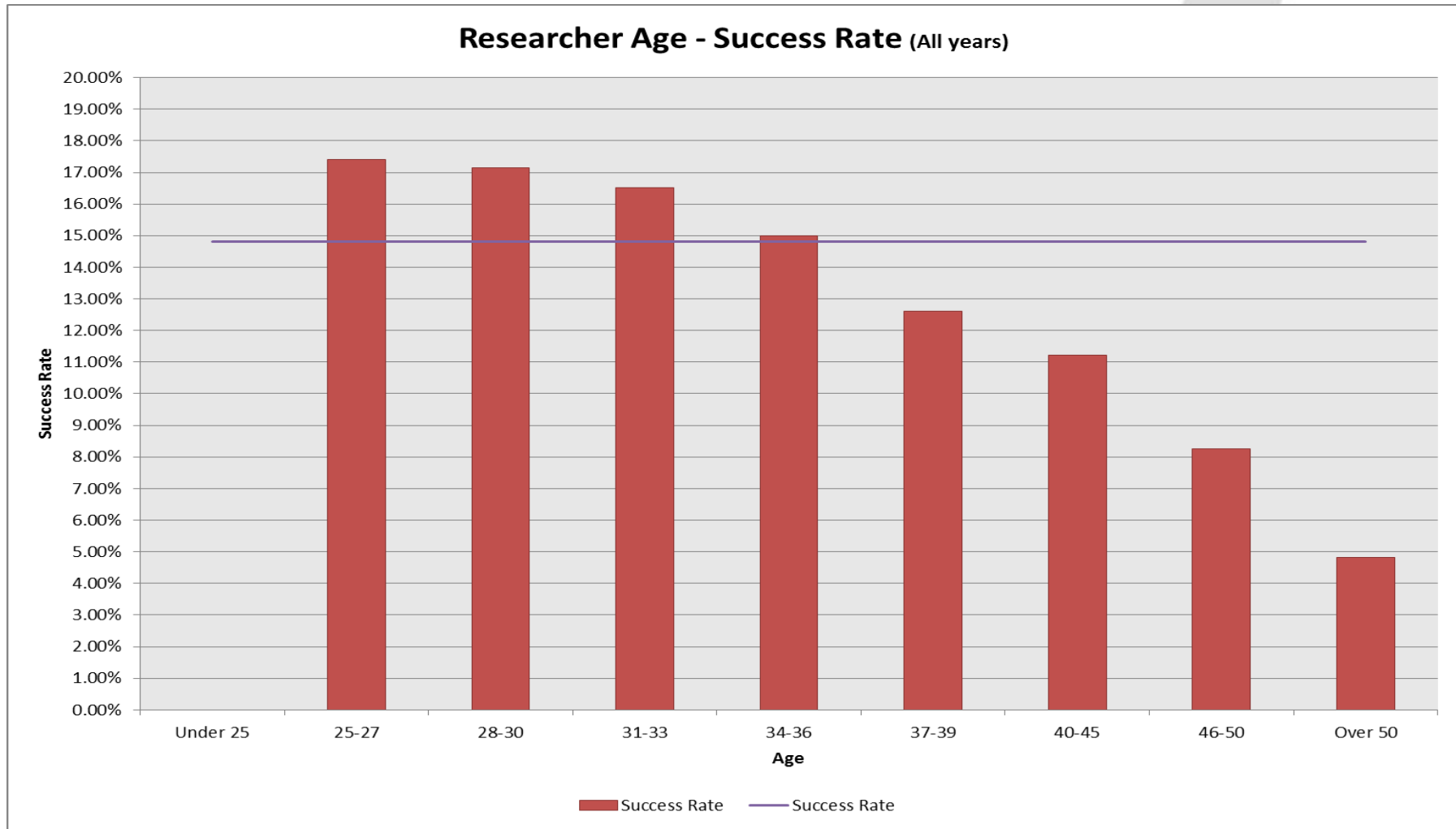

IF-GF 2017: Funded proposal per country (return phase)

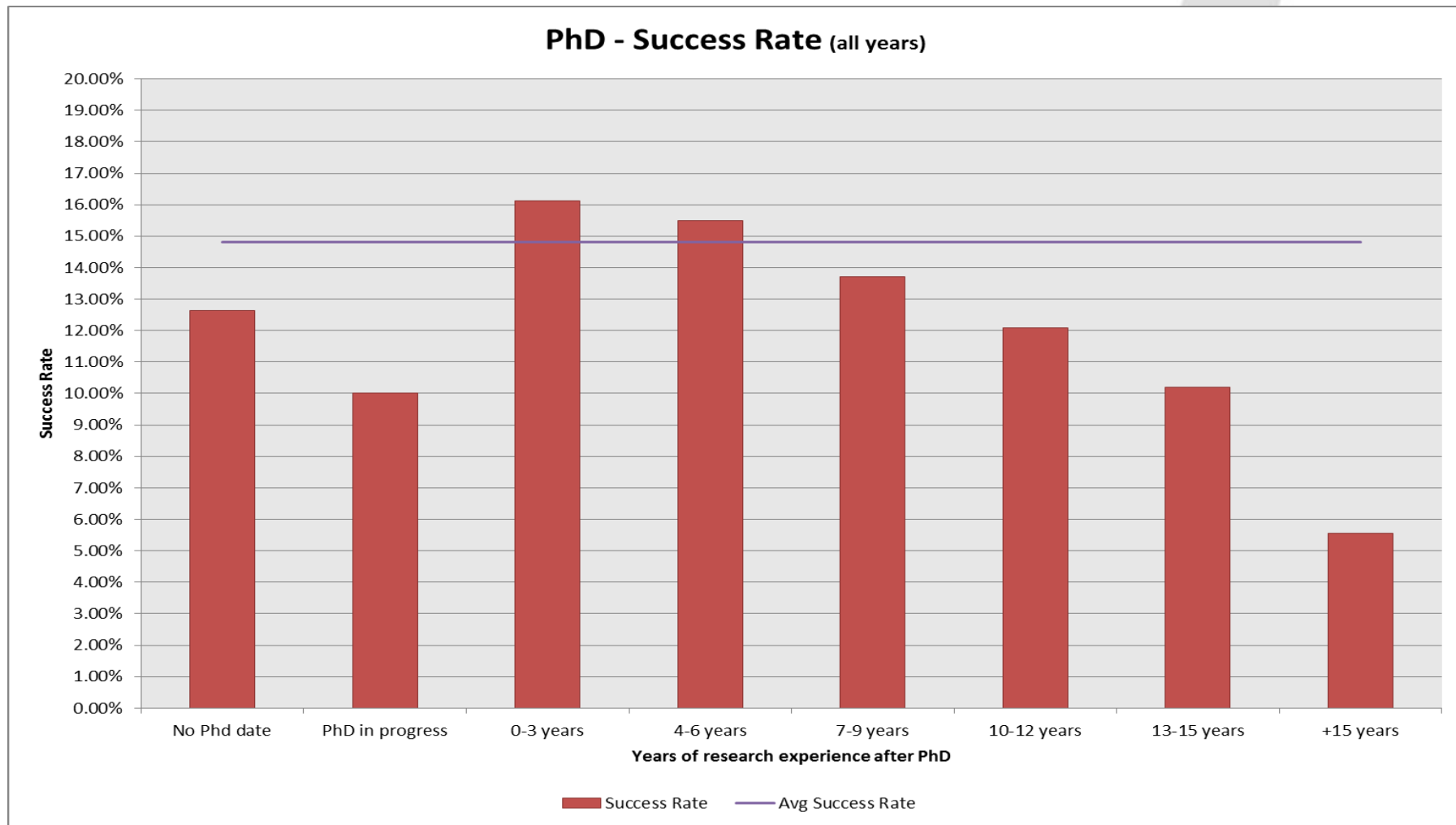
